



Selection procedure for participating in the B.O.S.S. Study Trip 2017

The application for the B.O.S.S. study trip 2017 to Shanghai and Tokyo will open at wednesday, 21st of December 2016. **The final deadline for the application is friday 17th of February, 2017 at 17:00h.**

Requirements for the students

There are some hard requirements for participating in the Study Trip; every potential participant:

- Has to be(come) a member of B.O.S.S.
- Has to be a Master student of the Faculty of Architecture and the Built Environment.
- Is obliged to follow the related elective course (3 ECTs) of the Study Trip, which takes place in Q4.
- Has to take part in the activities related to funding for the Study Trip such as in-house days.
- Has to take active part in all the (formal and informal) activities on location.
- Has to pay the specified amounts of money before each deadline. Deadlines will be announced when selection has taken place.
- The application should be written in English and needs to consist of:
 - **Resumé**
 - Motivation letter addressed to the Study Trip committee. A brief motivation of why you want to join the study trip, what your expectations are regarding to the research theme and course 'Event-led developments' and what your added value to the Study Trip is. An example motivation letter will be published. (Max. 400 words)

Selection procedure

The Study Trip 2017 offers 20 places for highly motivated students. In order to take part in this Study Trip, students have to apply before the **17th of February 2017, 17:00h**, by sending their resume and motivation letter (in English) to chairman@bosstudelft.nl. Since B.O.S.S. is the study association of the Master Management in the Built Environment, students of this Master will be prioritized.

The first selection will be made, based on the motivation letter and resume. Both will be anonymized by the chairman of B.O.S.S. before being reviewed by the Study Trip committee.

If the number of excellent applications still exceeds the available places, a second selection round will follow. In order to compose a mixed group of participants, the following ratios will be taken into account; national/international, first/second year, man/woman.

Finally the committee strives to select a group of highly motivated students that is representative for the TU Delft, as well as for B.O.S.S.
